Applicants must have **two** letters of recommendation written by teachers, advisors, or coaches. Please have application turned into the office by March 23, 2018. The selected applicant(s) will be announced at graduation.

### Criteria

High school graduate with an overall, minimum 2.0 GPA and will enter vocational training education the following semester. Traditional vocational programs, Associate Degree or Technical Diploma, typically require two years of full time course work with about 60 minimum credits.

## **Conditions for request of funds from scholarship recipients**

Scholarship checks payable to the recipient's educational facility are to be requested after the following.

- A letter from the student requesting fund to a particular school
- Copy of first semester schedule for 1<sup>st</sup> semester funds
- A copy of the student's grade report from the first semester or trimester
- A copy of the student's schedule for the next semester

## **Academic Performance Requirements**

The R&S Family Fund understands the transition aspect for first year college students; however, we do expect academic standards to be met. The following requirements must be met in order to receive continuation of scholarship payment.

- First semester GPA needs to be a minimum of a 2.0
- If the student earns a GPA lower than the required 2.0, scholarship payment will not be made for the second semester; however, the student will be given the opportunity to earn scholarship payment for the third semester if the following requirements are made:
  - Semesters one, two and three must be consecutive (no taking a semester off)
  - Student's cumulative GPA after semester two must be above a 2.0
  - Student must submit grade reports for both first and second semester along with confirmed schedule for semester three
- If the student does not meet the GPA requirements after semester two the scholarship is forfeited
- If the student is dismissed from the college, university, or technical institute as a result of poor academic performance all scholarship monies not paid are forfeited
